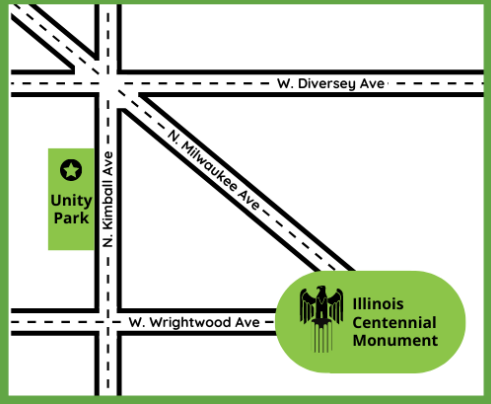

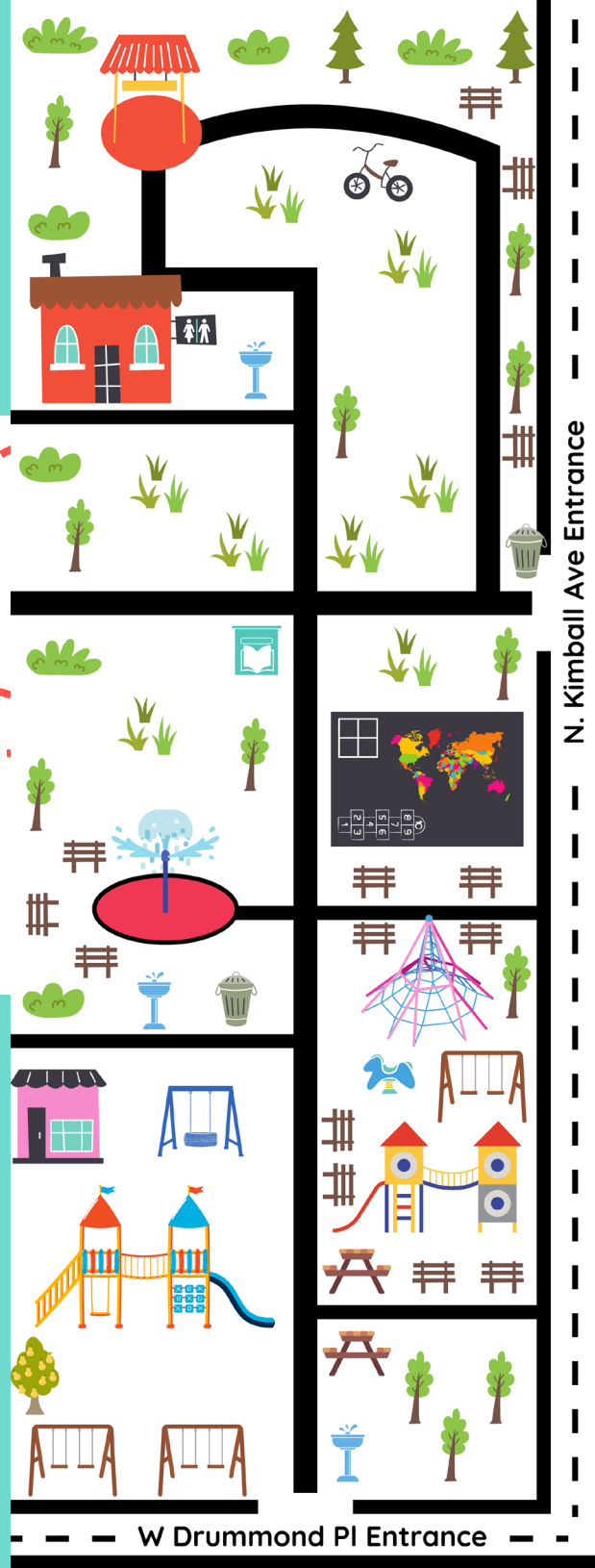

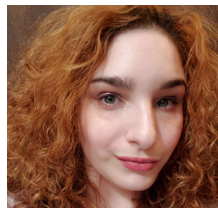
Lomai is a Chicago based writer/director who has begun to build an extensive and impressive list of credits, working on short films, videos and independent features, including his own debut

Glossary
